Footnotes

PLEAD rated off the pace, rallied and cut the corner to take over at the top of the stretch, drifted out while opening a clear lead, then responded when challenged by DODGING in deep stretch and just lasted over that rival. DODGING outrun early, raced four wide around the far turn, rallied to catch PLEAD in deep stretch and hung. SASTRE reserved off the pace, rallied to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't sustain his bid. GROVE HALL unhurried early, rallied to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out. WIRE CUTTER stalked the pace, was attempting to make a run at PLEAD when he drifted in in behind that rival at the sixteenth pole, checked and failed to recover. RATTLESNAKE RED unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals. CALL ME SWEETHEART well placed, made a run three wide to join the leaders on the far turn, then tired. HEAVY ON THEMISTER chased the pace along the rail into the far turn and faltered. SOCIAL QUALITY vied for the lead outside ALEJANDRO to the top of the stretch, then faded. SOUTHERN GROVE was done early. UNTAMEABLE was through after a half mile. ALEJANDRO vied for the lead to nearing the stretch, then had nothing left. There was a stewards inquiry into the incident in the stretch. No action was taken.
