ENGLAND'S ROSE never far back, came outside the leaders in early stretch and rallied under pressure to draw clear through the final sixteenth. RISEN MISS hopped at the start, moved up to force the pace, gained a slim lead in midstretch but couldn't match strides with the winner late. MANDALAY POINT saved ground and lacked the needed late response. LAS MOCHES (MEX) set the pace under pressure along the rail, then gave way in the drive. CLEARLY A QUEEN broke awkwardly, chased the pace three wide around the turn and weakened. CHAMPAGNE KIR was never a factor. SILKY'S TRIXIE trailed after breaking slowly.
