IN CLASSIC FASHION reserved early, raced four wide around the turn, then rallied to be up late. DAY DEE showed speed along the inside, responded when headed by LOX AND KIPPERS on the turn, regained the lead in the stretch but couldn't resist the winner late. LOX AND KIPPERS chased the pace from the outside, moved to gain a slim lead on the turn, then weakened in the drive. FROZEN PROSPECT chased the pace into the stretch but didn't do enough late. GUN HIGHWAY bumped with PUNTO FIJO at the start, tracked the leaders three wide around the turn, was bothered in the stretch and gave way. SWAMPY TOWN tracked the pace, was bumped hard by SWEEPING SILK on the turn and failed to recover. GREAT VICTORIAN chased the pace around the turn and gave way. PUNTO FIJO (URU) failed to menace after bumping with GUN HIGHWAY at the start. SWEEPING SILK reserved along the inside, steadied when he bumped with SWAMPY TOWN on the turn and was not a factor. FORTUNATE BUY was done early. CANT STOP ME was outrun after being steadied at the start.
