TOP BUSINESS set the pace along the rail, drew clear in early stretch, then was all out to just last over HERECOMESEVERYMAN. The latter, stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then rallied to just miss. ME NO EVIL reserved off the pace after being steadied soon after entering the first turn, rallied to reach the attending position in the stretch but didn't do enough late. ROCK ALEX prompted the pace outside TOP BUSINESS into the stretch and weakened. DRAMON allowed to settle after breaking slowly, raced three wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals. FRANCISCO'S BOY unhurried after hesitating at the start, improved his position without threatening. UNCLE JOE off slowly, was outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and failed to menace. CALPULLEC tracked the pace four wide to nearing the stretch, then gave way. HISTORICALLY was not a factor. AZUL COAST saved ground and tired. ONE SUPER CAT tracked the pace into the far turn and faltered. WISE WAGER chased the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn, then faded.
