PISTOL PEG bumped with RUN JASMINE RUN at the start, stalked the pace along the inside, eased out leaving the far turn, rallied gain the lead

approaching the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail while drifting out. WITCH'S ORCHARD reserved off the pace, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to reach PISTOL PEG in the stretch, but couldn't get to that rival while drifting out through the stretch. MARBLEHEAD HARBOR unhurried after being steadied in the early going, angled out for the drive and closed to be up for the show. MYSTIC CRYSTAL outrun after breaking slowly, angled out for the stretch run and closed outside MARBLEHEAD HARBOR to just miss the show. SETH'S TOY rated off the pace, advanced along the rail down the backstretch, was angling out when blocked in behind a wall of horses leaving the far turn, angled back in, then was steadied from tight quarters inside the eighth pole and gave way. MANDATED TO WIN allowed to settle after bobbling at the start, saved ground and passed tired rivals. RUN JASMINE RUN bumped with PISTOL PEG at the start, chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. DANCING RAKHA saved ground and failed to menace. MY BELLA DORA stalked the pace into the stretch, then was taken up from tight quarters at the eighth pole and failed to recover. LOVE A SOLDIER stumbled at the start, moved up quickly to set the pace along the rail to nearing the eighth pole, then faltered. MOETOWN GAL saddle slipped in the early going, chased the early pace, then faded and was eased in the stretch run.
