FESTIVAL QUEEN unhurried early, rallied to take over on the far turn and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to maintain here advantage to the finish. WITHLAPATIENCE reserved along the inside, steadied inside TRUST IN GOLD on the far turn, then closed to prove best of the rest while unable to gain on the winner late. NAUTICAL AGENT allowed to settle, passed tired rivals for the show. TWENTIETH OF MAY set the pace along the inside into the far turn, then tired. TRUST IN GOLD chased the pace to the far turn, then faltered. PAULA'S PILATES up close early, dropped back racing down the backstretch, then bolted on the far turn and was not persevered with thereafter.
