Footnotes

PERFORMING steadied from tight quarters on the first turn, moved up to stalk the pace into the stretch, rallied to catch MORE IS BETTER at the sixteenth pole and prevailed. MORE IS BETTER set the pace along the rail, opened a clear lead around the far turn, made the pace to the sixteenth pole and yielded. SOVEREIGN CRISIS tracked the pace along the inside, eased out in the stretch and was gaining slowly at the finish. SILVER ROCK (IRE) broke slow and bumped with SNOW TRIAL at the start, moved up to track the pace three wide into the stretch, then closed with a mild response. ITHINKIHADTHATONE reserved off the pace, gained some ground in the stretch without threatening. HOPE AND LUCK stalked the pace into the far turn and tired. SNOW TRIAL was no factor after breaking in the air and bumping with SILVER ROCK at the start. WAQUOIT'S DANCE was outrun.
