LILY RULES chased the pace, eased outside DANCEWITHDONNA on the turn, rallied to take over at the top of the stretch and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to prevail. SEXY THUNDER chased the pace three wide into the stretch and was gaining slowly at the finish. HOLY BLING rated off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and rallied for the show. ALTAMAR reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and had no response when asked. RUN KITTEN tracked the pace along the inside, eased out for the stretch run and rallied to loom a threat at the eighth pole, then tired. LITTLE MANDATE was no factor after being outrun early. SIMPLE ANSWER hopped at the start and was never a threat. DANCEWITHDONNA quickly sprinted to a long lead racing off the rail, made the pace to the top of the stretch, then faltered. JAMIE'S TICKET raced four wide and faded.
