CAPTAIN CRENCHE outrun early, raced four wide around the turn, then rallied to be up late. INDIAN FOG chased the pace off the rail into the stretch, then wore down MARIAS PASS to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. MARIAS PASS showed speed along the rail, edged clear around the turn and into the stretch, then gave way late. EDGE AHEAD tracked the leaders around the turn, then closed with a mild response. OUR REDEMPTION rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and never a threatened. ALICE'S ALEX off slowly, raced five wide around the turn and failed to menace. RUMBLETOWN pressed the early pace, chased MARIAS PASS along the inside around the turn, then faltered. INCLUDE TRACI saved ground and tired. WALK THE TIGER was outrun while racing four wide. WISE BLITZ showed little. HALO WEST reserved off the pace, faded on the turn.
