**Footnotes**

STREET APPEAL settled off the pace inside, bid angling outward through the turn, entered the stretch four wide, dueled for the lead inside the sixteenth pole and held on well. MISSY MINER stalked the pace toward the rail, contested for the lead at the top of the stretch and dug in gamely before reluctantly yielding inside the sixteenth pole. BRANDY BAI rated off the pace off the rail, eased five wide leaving the quarter pole and finished well toward the outside. LAUGHING MATTERS rated a slim lead two deep, moved clear nearing the turn, dueled with a slight deficit through the upper stretch then yielded with a sixteenth to go. TRULY BROADWAY rated off the pace about the three path, moved to near even terms three wide approaching the quarter pole then leveled off in the stretch. ALS BIG GIRL was not a factor. DANCE N RUN was shuffled back at the start, showed no speed outside and eased in the stretch.
