Footnotes

DEPOSIT ONLY dropped back from a brief early lead to stalk the pace three wide, threatened the pacesetter two deep on the turn, dueled with a slim advantage past the five sixteenths pole, drew clear midstretch and held on well. TRIPPI'S SAILOR stumbled at the start, rated close on the winners' heels toward the rail through the backstretch, eased three wide past the quarter, moved to the number two spot nearing the sixteenth pole and just lasted. SWEET N SOUR NINA, unhurried off the rail, eased outward on the turn, entered the stretch six wide, was closing slowly and just missed place. SPLENDID SOUND stalked the pace four wide and gave close chase through the turn before leveling off. REPUBLICAN showed no speed inside. PROUD TRIPPI moved to the lead for position at the rail to rate the pace, contested the turn inside and remained a factor to midstretch before giving way.
