ROCKETTES ESCAPADE reserved off the pace, swung out for the stretch run, then rallied while lugging in through the stretch to be up late. DREAMINGLY chased the pace, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides. TOWN FLIRT tracked the pace into the stretch, then closed with a mild rally to just miss the place. BROADWAY GHOST allowed to settle, advanced to reach contention in the stretch but couldn't gain late. THE GARDENER outran early, rallied along the rail to loom a threat in midstretch, then flattened out. PLEASANT HEIRESS outran DREAMINGLY for the lead, eased in on the backstretch to make the pace along the inside into the stretch, then tired. CALL TO SERVE rated off the pace, swung wide for the stretch run and failed to threaten. ORMOLU was not a factor. MOLLY MALONE chased the pace three wide to midway of the turn, then faltered.
