

MAGIC LILY set the pace under pressure into mid stretch then edged away under urging. NIFTY SHINDIG forced the pace while rank off the rail and gave way in the drive. CAJUN SUNRISE stalked the pace and weakened. TRUE BLUE NATION bumped with INDIAN RAIN at the start, was well placed saving ground and faded. INDIAN RAIN bumped and pinched back at the start between both ALEXANDRA'S STORM and TRUE BLUE NATION, raced up close three wide and tired. MAELYS HOPE was caught in tight after the start and never factored. ALEXANDRA'S STORM bumped with INDIAN RAIN at the start, chased the speed three wide and faltered. CHIFA trailed. THE JOCKEY ON MAELYS HOPE LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDERS OF BOTH CAJUN SUNRISE AND NIFTY SHINDIG FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE AFTER THE START. THE CLAIM OF FOUL HAS NOT BEEN ALLOWED.
