LOGAN'S PRESS CARD stalked the pace along the rail, moved to take over at the quarter pole and drew away under steady urging. CASTLEBROOK reserved early, raced three wide around the turn and closed to be up for the place while no threat to the winner. STARSHIP MISS made the pace racing off the rail, then weakened after losing the lead. MIZ UNITED STATES chased the pace into the stretch and lacked a rally. MISK off slowly, saved ground around the turn, then swung out for the drive and had no response. FREE OF CHARGE turned in a dull effort.
