**Footnotes**

MIA'S HALO reserved off the pace, rallied inside MAJESTIC MOOD and caught that rival late to prevail. MAJESTIC MOOD under restraint while stalking the pace, moved to take over on the far turn and continued on with good courage to save the place while unable to resist the winner. MARGIES DANCER steadied along the inside on the first turn, came between horses in the drive and closed fast to just miss the place. TASSO'S ANGEL unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn, angled in and finished willingly while working her way through traffic. MARATAYA'S DANCER saved ground, advanced into the stretch to reach contention but couldn't gain late. ANNIKA made the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn, then gave way in the stretch run. MADAWI well placed while racing three wide, tired. SNAKES HEATHER was always outrun. SHES JUST COOL showed little. CUT A CHECK was through after a half mile.
