KITTEN'S GIFT was away alertly to press the pace of FARLEYS MANDATE from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the quarter, vied through a prolonged drive and was up in the closing yards. FARLEYS MANDATE broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when challenged by the winner approaching the stretch, vied through a vigorous drive and just missed. IL VOLO showed no early speed, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with a late rally. FORALL THE MARBLES was never far back, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the three-eighths pole and failed to sustain his rally in the drive. SIMON WON'T SAY raced off the pacesetters from between foes throughout and finished evenly in the drive. BEST OF was forwardly placed early from the inside and lacked the needed rally. AYRTON was void of early speed, moved up for a contending position nearing the half, raced far wide through the second turn and failed to gain late. CATDUEL was hustled along early, checked nearing the seven-eighths pole, chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going three-quarters.
