ROLLBABY slow early, rallied three wide, took over in deep stretch and drew away under pressure. NEGRITA TATA in good position, rallied along the inside to gain a slim brief lead in midstretch and gave way late. HALO'S GATE well placed, improved her position to gain the show. IT'S NOT NICE stalked the pace on the inside and weakened. CASS offered a middle move while racing off the rail. BUMBA BUMBA allowed to settle, and was not a factor. E SVEIKATA set the pace on a clear lead three wide and tired.
