THREE PART HARMONY away alertly, led throughout racing off the rail and drew away when challenged turning for home under pressure. SAILING CLEAR chased the speed three wide, drew near even approaching the quarter pole and weakened. PRINCE OF SPEED never far back along the inside, faded. ROUGH'N ROYAL bumping with TANNERSVILLE at the start, was well placed three wide on the turn, angled in for the stretch run to no avail. The latter, exchanged bumps with ROUGH'N ROYAL at the start and was not a factor. HENRY THE GREAT showed little.
