STARSHIP SULTRY stalked the pace off the rail and lacked the needed late response. LEDA'S SWAN chased the speed and gave way. LEXINGTON PEARL allowed to settle, was not a factor. BAMA ROSE with the speed off the rail, weakened. SILVEREST raced up close and tired. INDY CROWN in good position four wide, faltered.
