HAPPY TO BE HERE led throughout along the rail and drew clear under pressure. GET BACK stalked the pace off the rail and proved best of the rest. AYRTON circled the field on the final turn, brushed with MECKE MANTLE turning for home and gained the show. IL VOLO chased the speed three wide and gave way. DIVINE MICHAEL checked in tight leaving the first turn and bumped with SIMON WON'T SAY then weakened. FULL RIDE off slowly, rushed to contention and tired. FARLEYS MANDATE stalked the pace on the inside and faded. MECKE MANTLE in good position, four wide on the final turn, brushed with AYRTON turning for home and faltered. PROFIRE broke out and didn't threaten. SIMON WON'T SAY bumped by DIVINE MICHAEL leaving the first turn and stopped.
