Footnotes

DON'T TELL LOU set the pace along the rail, then came out a bit in midstretch and was fully extended to hold off CHASETHEBLUESAWAY. The latter, stalked the pace along the inside, eased outside DON'T TELL LOU for the stretch run and was gaining slowly on that rival at the finish. WINDSOR GARDEN reserved racing along the inside, angled out for the stretch but didn't do enough late. HIGHLAND DANCER broke slowly, then checked in traffic on the first turn and failed to menace. GO SANDY GO stalked the pace three wide, then tired. DIAMOND SWEEP chased the pace into the far turn and faltered. STORMYS CONGRATS was through after six furlongs. THE TRAINER OF CHASETHEBLUESAWAY LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF DON'T TELL LOU FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH. THE CLAIM OF FOUL WAS NOT ALLOWED.
