Footnotes

BLUE BUSINESS stalked the pace, was boxed in along the rail from the top of the stretch to past the eighth pole, angled out for racing room and rallied under pressure to be up late. SWEETSOUTHERN TOWN chased the pace, moved to take over nearing the quarter pole and eased to the inside, then made the pace to deep stretch and yielded. REVERE'S RIDE rated off the early pace, moved up to chase the pace four wide around the turn, made a run at the leader in the stretch, then weakened. ROYAL APOLLO raced with the pace three wide to the top of the stretch and tired. NOTTA BOAT off slowly, rushed up along the inside to reach contention early, then faltered. GIANT VALLEY showed speed along the rail to midway of the turn, then faded. KAMINSKI was done early after breaking slowly.
