IN DANIEL'S BOOTS vied for the lead off the rail and weakened. HENRY THE GREAT off slowly, lacked the needed late response. BIG HENRY showed no speed and failed to menace. NOTTA BOAT well placed, tired. GOLDEN TORNADO never threatened. MOST WANTED hit the gate, raced in good position then faltered. ROYAL APOLLO vied for the early lead and faded.
