FOR TWO-YEARS-OLD. By subscription of \$200 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$2,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 Guaranteed. The owner of the winner to receive \$120,000; \$40,000 to second, \$22,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weight: 120 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 twice at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 at a mile or over on the turf, 5 lbs. \$50,000 or \$30,000 at a mile or over, 8 lbs.; \$25,000 or \$20,000 at a mile or over, 10 lbs.

Supplementary Nominations Closed Tuesday, November 2, 1999 with a fee of \$5,000 payable at time of entry. Closed Wednesday, October 6, 1999 with 65 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, this race will be run on the main track at 1 1/8 Miles.)

Footnotes

KING CUGAT, unhurried early and outrun while edging in to race four wide, reached easy striking distance approaching the far turn, was put to a steady drive leaving the half-mile ground, continued four wide into the stretch, gained a clear advantage and was kept to strong handling to hold FOUR ON THE FLOOR safe. FOUR ON THE FLOOR came out at the start bumping soundly with WHATA BRAINSTORM, exchanged bumps with that one again soon after, was outrun to the end of the backstretch while saving ground, moved out on the second turn to follow the winner five wide, loomed prominently for the drive and wasn't good enough. THADY QUILL moved up to vie for the lead early while racing in the three-path immediately inside GO LIB GO, held a narrow advantage until the stretch and weakened gradually. WHATA BRAINSTORM, bumped at the start by FOUR ON THE FLOOR, leaned in soon after and exchanged bumps with that one, saved ground in a striking position until the stretch but came up empty when the test came. LEEVON'S DREAM, sluggish to begin, failed to menace while improving position. U SO BAD, bumped lightly at the start, moved out to race five or six wide on the backstretch, then continued well off the inside while failing to rally. REALSHARP drifted in at the start and lightly bumped with U SO BAD, moved up to stalk the dueling leaders while saving ground but weakened in the drive. GO LIB GO bobbed slightly at the start, went up soon after to contest the pace outside THADY QUILL, dueled with that one for six furlongs and tired gradually.
