Footnotes

BOUCCANEER (FR) broke inward and hit the side of the gate, moved up to stalk the leaders under a rating hold four wide, took over in the upper stretch and widened under vigorous hand encouragement. SHAMROCK CITY lunged at the start while breaking a bit awkwardly, moved up nicely from the outside to gain a narrow advantage during the early stages, opened a clear lead on the first turn while continuing inside, showed the way until the upper stretch but wasn't a match for the winner in the drive. SHARP APPEAL, unhurried early while working his way in to race four wide behind horses, swung out five wide to loom menacingly when straightened for the drive but failed to gain in the final furlong. HIBERNIAN RHAPSODY (IRE) appeared rank during the early going and into the backstretch while attempting to climb along the inside, moved off the rail at the far turn while setting three wide between foes, remained

with the leaders into the stretch but came up empty while deadheating for fourth with JOE WHO (BRZ). The latter, bumped at the start, was within striking distance while in behind the leaders, made a mild run five or six wide concluding the second turn but gained only slightly in the drive while finishing evenly with HIBERNIAN RHAPSODY (IRE). TAKARIAN (IRE) leaned in at the start bumping JOE WHO (BRZ), moved inside, saved ground, failed to menace and was checked at the three-sixteenths. DIVIDE AND CONQUER was outrun until the stretch and not a threat while improving position. LAZY LODGE (ARG) moved up inside early to force the pace from between horses, held on well into the upper stretch and weakened. TANGAZI saved ground to no avail. INKATHA (FR) drifted out at the start bumping THE KAISER, raced prominently along the inside until the stretch and weakened gradually. THE KAISER, bumped at the start when breaking sluggishly and squeezed back in tight quarters soon after, saved ground until the stretch and never threatened after angling out 10-wide.
