Footnotes

ARTAX moved up soon after the start to vie for the lead outside of ENJOY THE MOMENT, took over about midway of the turn, opened a clear advantage in the upper stretch, then held KONA GOLD safe under strong handling in track record equalling time. KONA GOLD leaned in soon after the start bumping FURLOUGH, recovered quickly to reach contention while saving ground, made a bold run from the rail nearing the final furlong, loomed menacingly inside of ARTAX through deep stretch but wasn't good enough. BIG JAG, outrun until the stretch, came to the outside to secure room and finished willingly. FORESTRY bobbled at the start, quickly recovered to race within easy striking distance, was put to a drive leaving the three-eighths pole while five or six wide, raced prominently into the final furlong but lacked the needed response. SUCCESSFUL APPEAL raced forwardly between foes into the stretch and weakened. STRAVINSKY, full of run early, angled inside, moved swiftly to the leaders on the turn, loomed between horses three or four wide into the final

furlong but flattened out. GOOD AND TOUGH was outrun until the stretch, reached contention but lacked a further response. REGAL THUNDER stumbled at the start, was outrun until the stretch and not a threat while improving position. LEXICON, hung wide until the end of the backstretch, failed to reach contention. FURLOUGH, bumped at the start, was outrun while saving ground. VICAR raced between foes and was finished approaching the stretch. AFFIRMED SUCCESS, able to work his way inside by the turn, couldn't menace. SON OF A PISTOL, 10-wide on the backstretch, was finished early. ENJOY THE MOMENT was hustled to a slight advantage early, tired before going a half and gave way.
