Footnotes

ANEES was bumped soon after the start while breaking a bit slow, was then checked in tight quarters behind FOREST CAMP. ANEES was outrun into the backstretch, moved inside, saved ground while rallying into contention on the second turn, came out to advance from between rivals five wide nearing the stretch, lugged in briefly when straightened for the drive, then, after being sharply roused with the whip lefthanded, finished strongly while drifting out late. CHIEF SEATTLE settled inside early, moved three wide to advance approaching the stretch, reached the front when straightened for the drive, then wasn't a match for the winner late. HIGH YIELD was within easy striking distance from early on, made a bid along the rail approaching the far turn, came out four wide soon after, moved menacingly on about even terms for the lead into the stretch, then flattened out late. MULL OF KINTYRE settled early, was rated along in behind horses, saved ground for six furlongs, came out to make a run six wide into the stretch but failed to sustain the needed momentum. DIXIE UNION, five or six wide much of the way, failed to threaten while improving position. FOREST CAMP drifted in at the start, went up to press pacesetting PERSONAL FIRST, moved swiftly to gain command on the second turn, held on well until the stretch and weakened. BRAHMS, wide much of the way, passed tired ones. PERSONAL FIRST, sprinted clear inside early, made the pace until near the end of the backstretch and tired. CHARLIE'S BEAU failed to reach contention. MILLENCOLIN was well placed early while inside between foes, exchanged bumps with CAPTAIN STEVE at the half-mile ground and tired. CAPTAIN STEVE was forwardly placed early, exchanged bumps with with MILLENCOLIN approaching the end of the backstretch and tired. GRAEME HALL was never prominent. HUGH HEFNER, was finished early as was KISS A NATIVE.
