BAD DEBT in good position, rallied to assume command off the rail on the final turn then drew off under urging. BLAMESHIFTER unhurried early, improved his position to be up for the place while no match for the winner. TRIPLE CROSS allowed to settle, rallied off the rail to gain the place then gave way. HAPPY MY WAY stalked the pace and weakened. BALINO moved out to a clear lead after vying briefly, saved ground and tired. MAJESTIC EXPRESS void of early speed, failed to menace. RULE NUMBER SIX was not a factor after bobbling at the start.
