HEY LEROY reserved off the pace, eased out for the stretch run, then rallied to took over inside the eighth pole and drew off under urging. SOLICITATION tracked the pace into the stretch, then closed to be just up for the place while no match for the winner. STARSHIP WINDSOR set the pace along the rail, drew clear around the far turn and into the stretch, then gave way. CHUFFED TO BITS failed to menace. CANTINERIO unhurried after breaking slowly, swung out while rallying into contention around the far turn, then tired in the drive. WILKO'S BULLET off slowly, rated off pace, raced three wide around the far turn and faltered. TOP EXCITEMENT broke slowly, then was no factor while racing four wide. KENNY'S Z stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then faded. A NICE RENDITION chased the pace off the rail into the stretch, then had nothing left. COLOSSIANS chased the pace into the far turn, then was dropping back when checked from close quarters on the rail.
