TAPICAT set all the pace along the inside and held gamely to be clear under strong pressure. TOKYO TIME pressed the pace, raced three wide through the far turn into the upper stretch and finished second best. AUNTIE MARTHA stalked the pace, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and had no final winning bid. JUDY G was allowed to settle early, raced four deep in the stretch and had no final kick. EAR D' RHYTHM hesitated at the start, raced towards the inside and never was a factor. URQUIA stalked the pace along the inside and weakened in the stretch. PUTITINMYPCKET failed to respond. LA BARBIE NIKI was off a step slow, raced three deep and never was a factor. TEQUILAWTYLIGHTNIN showed little. NAKED WATCH trailed throughout.
