FOLK SINGER outran MR. CLINTON for the lead around the first turn, eased in to make the pace, drew clear around the far turn, then was all out to last over VOLCANO RUN. The latter, reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, then rallied to just miss. DATEFUL GRED tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and finished willingly. DR. KENNEY rated off the pace, saved ground into the stretch and closed with a mild response. THE LAURELS allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn and improved position. ALLARD outran after breaking slowly, raced three wide around the

far turn and passed tired rivals. MR. CLINTON chased the pace along the rail into the far turn, then tired. EL GATOR off slowly, was not a factor. SCAPPARE was outrun. ASSIMILATION was through after a half mile. WISE WAGER broke slowly, saved ground and faltered. CORTADITO chased the pace into the far turn, then faded.
