RAVELO'S BOY unhurried early, was racing three wide when put to pressure on the far turn, then rallied to be up late. ANGEL'S TUNE prompted the pace outside MY PEOPLE, took over from that rival on the far turn and opened a clear lead but couldn't resist the winner late. HERE WE GO JOE bumped with SARAVA'S DANCER at the start, then steadied in traffic on the first turn, tracked the leaders into the stretch but couldn't stay with the top ones while up for the show. SARAVA'S DANCER reserved off the pace after bumping with HERE WE GO JOE at the start, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch, then gave way. HOLLYWOOD SCRIPT tracked the leaders off the rail into the far turn and tired. MY PEOPLE bobbled at the start, set the pace along the rail to midway of the far turn, then faltered. GURI well placed early, faded.
