Footnotes

EDEN'S EXCHANGE rated off the pace after breaking slowly, steadied when trapped behind a wall of horses in the stretch, angled out for room and closed

with a rush to be just up at the wire. TOO CLEVER BY HALF pressed the pace outside ORMOLU, took over from that rival on the far turn and opened a clear lead, then just failed to last. SHAKEIRA tracked the pace four wide around the far turn, then rallied to just miss the place while dead heating with BE MY CANDY. The latter, tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and rallied to just miss the place while finishing on even terms for the show. OUR SWEET SURPRISE unhurried early, circled rivals five wide around the far turn and finished willingly. BALA PERDIDA stalked the pace between horses, made a run to loom a threat in midstretch, then gave way. PELEADORA FUERTE allowed to settle, saved ground into the stretch and closed ground late. ORMOLU set the pace along the rail to the quarter pole, then tired. CINDY'S JOY failed to menace. TAKE ME TO ZUBER stumbled at the start, then steadied in traffic on the first turn, stalked the leaders along the rail into the stretch and faltered. IMPERIAL JIVE reserved off the pace, faded on the far turn. SARATOGA BLITZ hit the gate at the start, then was done early while racing four wide.
