Footnotes

STORMY THE CAT reserved early, steadied in traffic on the far turn, angled out for room in the stretch, then rallied to be up late. STORM WARNINGS chased the pace along the inside, eased out and rallied to take over inside the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner late. TOP BUSINESS rated off the pace, rallied along the rail to reach even terms for command at the eighth pole but was outfinished. TOH'S GREY CAT set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch while maintaining the advantage to the eighth pole, then weakened. SILENT TAP stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. SMOKIN STAR allowed to settle, advanced three wide around the far turn but had no further response. LUCKY ZIP failed to menace while racing three wide. BALTIMORE SAINT unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and never threatened. SHARKBAIT OOH HAHA chased the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. JUPITER was outrun. ALTO COLORADO steadied on the first turn, saved ground and faltered.
