Footnotes

CLEMENT ROCK took up at the start, moved up five wide in the stretch and finished gamely to get up under steady handling. TARGET SIGHTED was allowed to settle, moved up five wide into the lane and finished second best. CONCERT STAGE stalked the pace, raced three wide in the stretch and finished willingly to the wire. STRIKE THE TIGER stalked the pace, saved ground throughout and had no final winning bid. JUST PLAYIN AROUND stalked the pace from the outside, raced four wide into the upper stretch and had no late bid. TANZANA set all the pace, raced just off the inside and weakened in the final stages. FUNDIT dropped back early, raced four wide deep and never was a factor.
