Footnotes

CHOSEN HEIR set all the pace, raced just off the inside and prevailed under strong encouragement. LUNAR RED was slow early, saved ground throughout, finished gamely and just missed. HERE COMES DRZ was unhurried early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and showed good late interest. DR. GOLDFARB pressed the pace from the outside and weakened a bit in the drive. SON OF A TRAMP was allowed to settle early, moved up three wide through the far turn, steadied briefly at the quarter pole and made a mild late gain. JONATHAN C was slow early, moved up six wide into the stretch and never was a serious threat. ARTHUR stalked the pace from the outside, raced four deep and weakened a bit in the latter stages. COLORADO

DAYDREAM stalked the pace while racing between horses and weakened in the lane. STANDFIRE was forced five wide around the first turn, raced four deep in the lane and never was a factor. BLUE KING showed little. MONEY IN ACTION was slow early, raced four deep into the upper stretch and never menaced. SATURNUS was up close early, tired readily and was eased up on in the latter stages.
