**Footnotes**

TRICKY HAT (CHI) tracked the leader while racing just off the inside, took command and held gamely in the final stages under strong handling. CHANGE OF COMMAND stalked the pace, moved up four wide at the quarter pole and finished willingly to the wire. REFLECTING was unhurried early, moved up four wide in the stretch and closed ground gamely in the latter stages. SHETAN was unhurried early, raced three wide in the stretch and made a mild late gain. BUZZ THE DEPUTY set all the pace along the inside and gave way. QUANTITY dropped back early, raced four deep and never was a factor. FACT showed little. TOTAL REWARD settled off the early pace and failed to have a response. WARRANT stalked the pace, raced three deep and never menaced. CHANNEL QUEST failed to sustain a bid.
