Footnotes

DEANAALLEN'SKITTEN was unhurried while held up toward the rear through the opening six furlongs, swung six wide on the far turn and once in the clear launched a furious rally through the lane to drive to the lead inside the final furlong, held off the late rush of ROCK ON BABY despite drifting out a bit late. ROCK ON BABY trailed early, followed the eventual winner into the turn and swung outside that rival leaving the turn to be seven wide heading into the stretch, closed well while gaining on that one late. BRANDYS SECRET dictated the pace, yielded inside the final eighth. SHARAPOVA SLAMS chased from the two to three path, didn't have enough late. HARBINGEROFTHINGS settled off the pace early, shifted four to five wide on the far turn to commence a bid just inside the top two but couldn't keep stride with them while still managing to improve position in the lane. GRANDMA'S RULES raced just off the inside, moved through traffic, evenly. MARATAYA'S TUNE attended the pace racing close up and just off the inside, gave way late. NEGRITA TATA was close early racing inside, weakened. MARIE'S MUSIC raced inside under cover, had no rally. RARO raced mid-pack through the opening stages, made a mild bid three wide on the far turn, flattened out. EDIE floated four wide into the first turn, stalked from that vantage point down the backstretch, offered no late response.
