DUST AND DIAMONDS set all the pace, raced just off the inside throughout and drew off in the final stages under a steady hand ride. GOLDEN MYSTERY stalked the pace, moved up four wide into the stretch and finished second best. NAKANO stalked the pace while saving ground, swung out four wide in the stretch and made good late gain. SACRISTY was allowed to settle early, raced five wide into the upper stretch and had not enough in the latter stages. HONEY CHILE pressed the pace along the inside and tired. HEARTS OF RED stalked the pace while racing between rivals and tired the final eighth of a mile.
