ABACO was slow early, raced five wide nearing the quarter pole and finished gamely to edge clear under steady handling. ANGEL'S SOUTH stalked the pace, raced towards the inside, led deep stretch couldn't match strides with the winner in the final stages. ROMIN ROBIN was unhurried early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and made a good late gain. MILLENNIA dropped back early, raced four wide in the stretch and made a mild late gain. ARMARANTE stalked the pace, saved ground and had no final winning bid. AZAMEERA (IRE) pressed the pace from the outside and weakened while racing three deep. ULTIMATE CLASS set all the pace and gave way. RINELLA BAY showed little. DOVE SEASON failed to sustain a bid.
