POMEROYS PISTOL stalked the pace, eased out for the stretch run, then rallied to catch PICA SLEW nearing the sixteenth pole, then drew clear under urging. PICA SLEW chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over leaving the turn, made the pace to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner late. STRIKE THE MOON rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn but couldn't get to the top one while just missing the place. CATCH A THIEF reserved racing along the inside, gained some ground without threatening. INDULGENCE unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and gained ground late. THIRD CHANCE showed speed along the inside to nearing the top of the stretch, then gave way. MOONTUNE MISSY was not a factor. ROMAN TREASURE stalked the pace three wide around the turn and faltered.
