EAST OF DANZIG rated off the pace, rallied four wide around the far turn to gain a slim lead in the stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. FOURSEVENTEEN stalked the pace three wide, made a run to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn, then responded when EAST OF DANZIG moved to the fore in the stretch and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. BWANA BRAVE unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied for the show. BIG TOP stalked the pace into the stretch but didn't do enough late. HUGO LIGHT vied for the lead outside ANDYSUN to the quarter pole, then tired. HOUNGUN failed to menace. UNO AGAIN was not a factor. STRATEGIC DEFENSE was never a threat. KITTEN IN MAY was outrun after breaking poorly. ALEJANDRO showed little while racing three wide. SOUL SILENCE reserved off the pace, saved ground and faltered. ANDYSUN vied for the lead along the rail to the quarter pole, then faded.
