HIGHLAND SARA reserved off the pace, rallied between rivals to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole and edged away. BLACK AND WHITE tracked the pace off the rail, angled out for the stretch run and rallied for the place. MS BLOOMFIELD HIGH chased the pace four wide into the stretch and gained the show while being outfinished by the top ones. CHRISTMAS TRIPPI tracked the pace five wide into the stretch and had no late response. QUIET TIARA chased the pace three wide, moved to gain a slim lead in the stretch, then gave way. WHY SHOULD I pressed the pace outside TWYLIGHT COCKTAILS into the stretch, then tired in the final eighth. TWYLIGHT COCKTAILS showed speed along the inside into the stretch and faltered. NATALIE'S GOAL off a step slowly, saved ground around the turn and faded.
