RAPID RUNNER reserved early, angled four wide on the turn, swung out widest of all for the stretch run, then rallied to be up in time. PENITANT PRAYERS tracked the pace, dropped back racing around the turn, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. IN SPEIGHT OF IT chased the pace three wide into the stretch and closed for the show while being outfinished by the top ones. PEB HUGHES vied for the lead along the inside, drew clear in the stretch but couldn't resist the top ones in the final strides. BUTLER CABIN well placed racing along the rail, finished willingly. SATURDAY HERO unhurried early, rallied to reach contention in the stretch but was blocked in behind a wall of horses late and couldn't do his best. SEND HIM IN vied for the lead outside PEB HUGHES, then tired in the drive. EMPTY HANDED was outrun.
