Footnotes

HAUNTED settled in behind the early pacesetter, began to advance position heading into the turn, raced two wide in the top of the lane and edged past JAMIE'S BOY in the late stretch. JAMIE'S BOY took command early and continued clear racing along the inside, was challenged by HAUNTED in the late stretch and finished second best. HAPPY HARVEY raced along the inside and stalked the early front runners, made a bid heading into the turn and raced three wide in the stretch. WON KOOL KID raced up close in the early going, saved ground along the inside and had no late kick in the drive. VERO'S HERO stalked the early front runners, raced three wide heading into the turn and finished evenly in the stretch. LEGAL POWER reserved early, raced four wide in the turn and failed to threaten in the stretch. FORT BOONESBOROUGH raced evenly in the back of the pack.
