ORIENT MOON tracked the early front runner racing along the inside, edged up to JUST BLESSED heading into the turn, vied for the lead in upper stretch, shook free from rival at eighth pole and continued clear. JUST BLESSED took command in the early going, continued the leader heading into the turn, was challenged by ORIENT MOON in upper stretch and could not match strides with rival in the drive. PRO D'ORO settled in near the back of the pack early, made a five wide bid in the turn and steadily gained ground five wide in the stretch. MANY CROWNS tracked the early front runners, raced three wide in the turn and failed to rally in the stretch. WYATT'S WOMEN was reserved in the early going, raced along the inside and slightly improved position in the stretch. CRAFTY PUSH saved ground racing along the inside, made a bid in the stretch, slightly improved position but had no kick late. TRANSGRESSION raced three wide in the turn and failed to be a threat.
