Footnotes

ALKE JOHN tracked the leaders along the inside, got the jump on the closers as he made a nifty move up the rail into the far turn to quickly spurt to a clear advantage, held a diminishing lead through upper stretch when confronted by a rival outside, dueled with that one through the final furlong but gamely held him at bay. CYTHEREAN pressed the pace three wide, had aim on the eventual winner and dueled with that one through the final eighth but was unable to get by after a long drive. FORT BOONESBOROUGH settled off the pace racing off the inside, improved position, evenly. FOOLISH TIGER steadied twice

when caught in a tight spot between and behind rivals on the first turn, moved up three wide. HE'S HOLLYWOOD dropped in toward the rail on the first turn, raced just off the rail while steadily advancing down the backstretch, saved ground just off the inside on the far turn, angled to the four path in upper stretch, continued to pass foes through the lane. BEER GARDEN was bumped at the start, raced four wide, was asked to pick it up on the far turn but came up empty. TRUST THE DEPUTY raced four wide, never threatened. H M S ANNIVERSARY bumped a foe at the start and failed to factor thereafter. NUMB LIPS raced toward the rear off the inside in about the three path, had no late bid. SPORTING HOLIDAY was content to settle at the rear early, had no response. PECKY'S BOY was hard used in being sent to the front from the start, set a pressured pace, gave way after half.
