MOVE OVER stalked the early front runners, made a bid heading into the turn, raced three wide at the top of the lane, inched up to leader midstretch, edged by and was clear late. MY DADDY'S DOLLARS took command in the early going, continued to be the leader by a comfortable margin heading into the turn, was challenged by MOVE OVER midstretch and settled for second place. BILLOS BOY stalked front runners racing near the rail, raced two wide in the turn and slightly improved position. TIZ A PAR raced four wide in the turn and continued a steady bid in the stretch. PLENTY OF POPP raced five wide in the turn and failed to be a threat in the stretch. HIDDEN MONEY raced up close in the early going, continued along the inside and had nothing left late. RANDY'S REFLECTION lacked response throughout.
