Footnotes

TARGET SIGHTED settled nicely at the rear racing inside, advanced inside into the far turn, shifted out and weaved through traffic, found a seam at the top of the lane and quickly spurted clear, was geared down late. FAVORITE KETCH settled mid-pack racing off the inside, swung six wide into the lane, was second best. DECAF AGAIN trailed early racing between runners two wide, continued to trail down the backstretch racing off the inside, gained ground and position on the far turn from that same vantage point, followed the winner's path to the wire to capture show. NOBLE DOSS saved ground inside just off the pace, shifted outside foes into the turn but had no late rally. FIRE MISSION raced wide throughout, made a strong middle move to reach contention five wide on the far turn, flattened out. NORTHWOOD BULLY raced three wide on the first turn, dropped back off the pace down the backstretch, was swung to mid-track for the stretch run and passed tired foes. HOLD THAT CAMERA was urged early and showed no speed racing well off the rail, was five wide into the lane and drifted out through upper stretch, passed tired foes late. RECHARGED was caught four to five wide on the first turn racing close up, advanced well outside in a middle move down the backstretch, faltered, faded. EXETER ROAD raced three wide toward the rear around the first turn, settled in the rear down the backstretch racing off the rail, advanced inside foes on the far turn and into the lane while swinging five to six wide, flattened out late. BOMBINO was inside till the far turn at which point he shifted four wide, lugged out a bit entering the stretch, faded, tired. GO JOE GO showed brief speed, was done after half. SKIBO IN JULY dropped inside early to save ground, raced close up till the far turn, gave way. REGULAR BUSINESS raced four to five wide, failed to menace.
