Footnotes

HAPPY MY WAY got away alertly and was content to rate nicely just off the flank of the pacesetter racing well off the rail in the two or three path, assumed command once that one began to tire while still racing off the inside, drifted out a bit on the turn, spurred clear through the lane under a drive. SPEECHIFY bobbled slightly at the break, chased the pacesetters just off the inside in, shifted out to the three path to commence a bid, was floated four to five wide on the turn, no match for the winner but clearly second best. CAPITAL CITY rated off the pace racing in the three or four path, edged closer from that vantage point, angled inside foes at the three sixteenths, lacked closing kick. TULIRA CASTLE advanced four wide into the far turn, was guided inside foes from the four path to the rail midway on the turn, cut that corner and continued to run well in upper stretch along the rail, altered course to angle outside a foe mid-stretch but couldn't get by that one before the wire. LIVINGSTON SWAGGER passed tired rivals. SWEET ROCKET MAN raced inside, had no bid. JAY EYE SEE was no factor. BOB AND THE GANG was outrun. VALUE TRAP showed brief speed along the inside, was done early.
